Family Mähler-Besse

Since the acquisition of the Château de Montaigne in 1860, the Family Mähler-Besse, seventh generation owner, are really involved in producing wines that are a pure reflection of the terroir of their property.

Today, the owner of the Château of Montaigne are always share-holder of Château Palmer, and manage the wines of their Estate with the same level of quality and expression as they do in Margaux.

The vineyards are on the same soils of the hills of Saint-Emilion and its historical and exceptional terroir, that is enhanced by a vinification of quality with no compromises.

The vineyards are on a great historical terroir for sweet white, very close to the famous Monbazillac appellation. A vinification with no compromises brings very high the potential of the soil and grapes.



Vintage 2019 :

The Vintage 2019 is in line with great Vintages like 2018, 2015, 2010 et 2009, in term of quality.

A nice balance between the fruit and the acidity makes a very enjoyable vintage.

Tasting notes :

The colour is shiny gold, on the nose some aromas of candied fruit, pear and quinces.

A nice balance in the mouth, with a glimpse of acidity that helps to keep the freshness and vivvacity, with a nice finish on the fruit.



Harvest :

From the 25th of september to the 10th of october.

Blend :

90% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Sauvignon Gris.

Bottled : September 2020.
