GRAPE VARIETY : Syrah, Mourvèdre, Grenache, Cabernet Sauvignon

TERROIR : Clay-limestone and sandy-loam, gravelly **ALCOHOL CONTENT** : 13,5% Vol

CELLARING : Drink now or within 5 years.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

AGEING : 12 months in 32 hl foudres, amphorae made of natural concrete and stainless-steel.

TASTING NOTES

Wine with a ruby colour and garnet reflections. The nose evokes red fruits, morello cherry, kirsch supported by toasted notes. A well-balanced wine with a persistent finish.

Pair with a Provençal stew, a pink lamb or a ganache with fleur de sel.

CHÂTEAU D'ESTOUBLON'S 2017 VINTAGE

Winter was mild and dry at Estoublon, as it was throughout Provence. Spring, also very dry, was marked by an incident of frost in April, which unfortunately affected some of our vines. Flowering went very quickly in early June, in particularly hot weather. At the start of the summer, the vineyards were exceptionally healthy, thanks to the combination of the Mistral wind and the lovely weather over the spring. The ensuing summer was also very hot and dry with a few small localized thunderstorms. The end-of-summer conditions concentrated the sugars, acids and aromas into small, plump grapes.
